4 NEW SECTIONS TO THE WATER AND SEWER CODE UNDER
5 TITLE 13 CHAPTER 13.06. & 13.07 TITLED FATS, OILS &
6 GREASE (FOG) MANAGEMENT POLICY AND ENFORCEMENT
7 RESPONSE PLAN, RESPECTIVELY, AS PART OF THE CITY
8 WATER AND SEWER CODE AND AMENDING ORDINANCES
9 NO. 405, 755, 794, 06-904, 07-906, 08-923, 09-973, 16-1062 AND
10 RESOLUTION 11-866, ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY OF
11 COMPONENTS OF ORDINANCE; AND ESTABLISHING AN
12 EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

13 **WHEREAS**, the City of Douglas is committed to compliance with State and Federal environmental laws
14 and guidelines; and

15 **WHEREAS**, this City Ordinance indirectly amends all noted Ordinances and Resolutions and establishing
16 new sections to Title 13 of the Douglas Municipal Code under Title 13.06 & 13.07 to be titled Fats, Oils &
17 Grease (FOG) Management Policy and Enforcement Response Plan, respectively; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the City's Public Services Code allows the City to make modifications to the provision of
19 water and sewer services and for environmental legislation compliance; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the City Council now finds that in order for the City's Public Service Services Code to be in
21 full compliance county, state, federal, health, safety, environmental, hazardous materials or other
22 governmental or public agency codes, ordinances, regulations, or orders with respect to the City Public
23 Services and wastewater system, it is necessary to establish this new program.

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglas,
25 Arizona, as follows:

Section 1. Establishing Title 13.06 titled Fats, Oils & Grease (FOG) Management Policy & Chapter 13.07
titled and Enforcement Response Plan, of the City of Douglas Water and Sewer Code under Title 13 of the
Municipal Code, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and incorporated herein by reference as though fully set
forth herein verbatim is approved amending the noted Ordinances and Resolutions at the time this
ordinance becomes effective.

Section 2. Severability. If any chapter, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is
for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction,
such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
